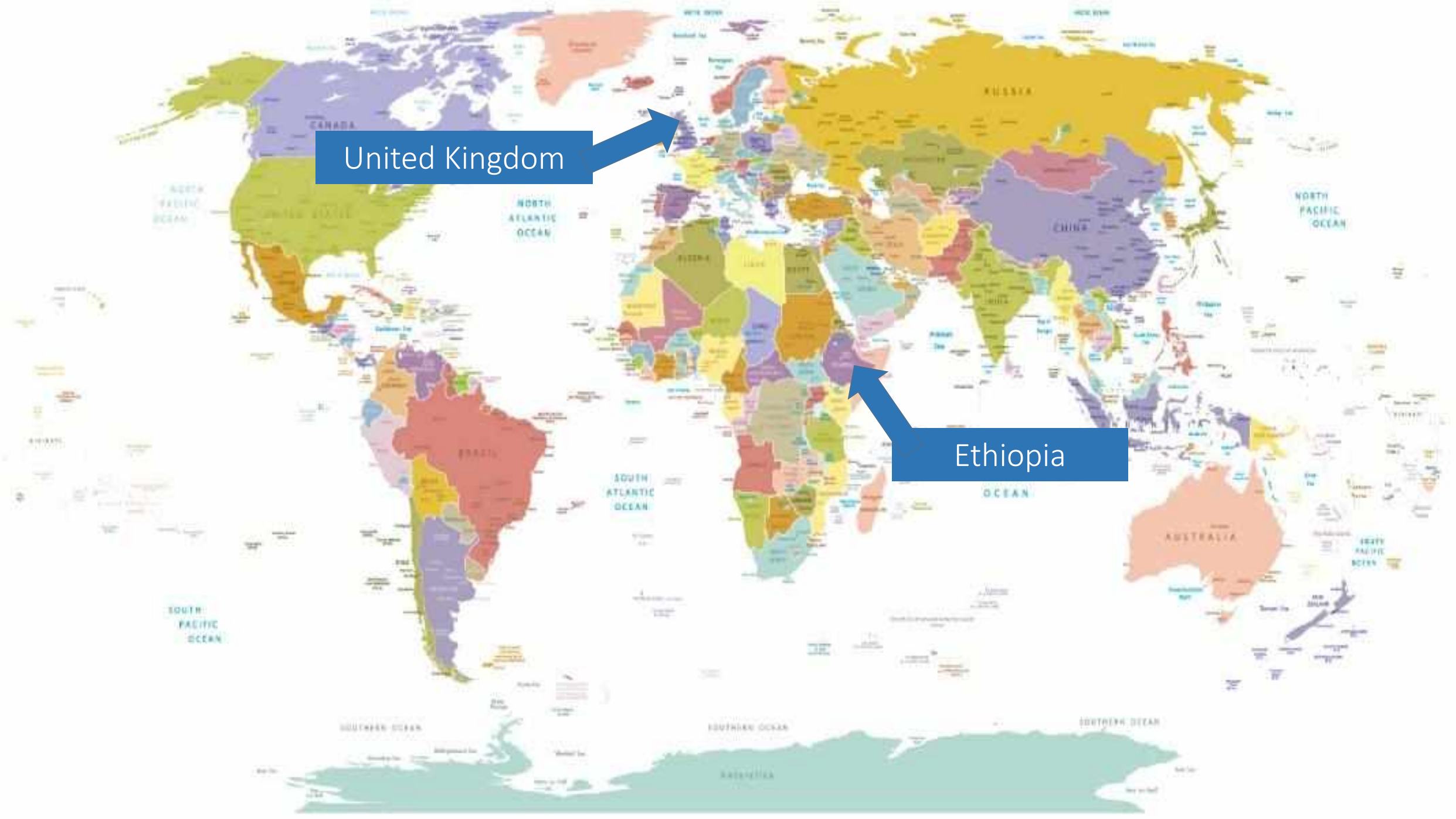




Let's travel to Ethiopia.
